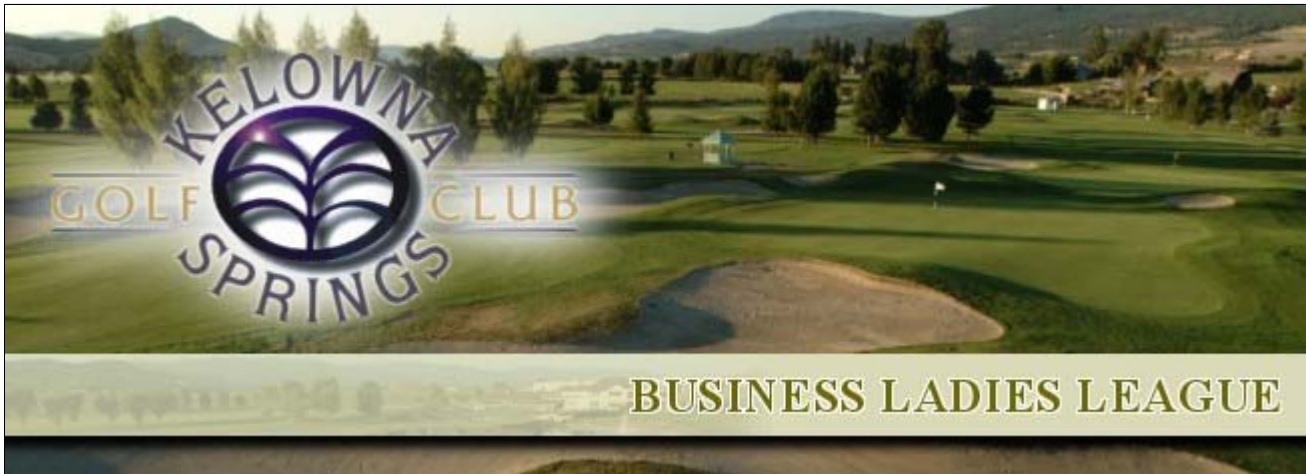

OPENING DAY - APRIL 2nd

Welcome ladies to another season of golf at Kelowna Springs Golf Club. The league is a "Nine" hole social, fun league, making new friendships, enjoying some laughs, learning some new golf rules and etiquette and hopefully improving our games. Although this is a fun league the rules of golf do apply....

MEMBERSHIP FEES

The league membership remains at \$32.00, this fee must be paid by April 23rd. The early bird draw will be held on April 16th for all paid members. The lucky member will have her membership fee of \$32.00 reimbursed....

GREEN FEES

In order for everyone to maintain an even pace there are a few rules and request we need to address.

Tee times for a 4 hour - 18 hole play must be booked between 12 and 1:04.

All league play after 3:15 is for NINE hole play only (note that there are no tee times available between 1:12 and 3:08).

Green Fees for a 9 hole play will be \$23.00 including GST, with the mandatory \$5.00 weekly prize fee, which totals \$28.00

Green Fees for 18 hole play up to 1:04PM will be \$35.00 including GST, with the mandatory \$5.00 weekly prize fee, which totals \$40.00

TEE TIMES

Tee times will continue to be booked on a "Ballot" procedure. Prior to beginning your game please fill out a ballot with your 1st and 2nd choice of tee times. If you can't make your tee time please make sure you contact the Pro Shop.

The tee times are posted on the bulletin board outside of the ladies washroom....

Both front and back nines will be played each week. For handicap purposes, try to alternate your play from the front and back nine each week.

Please ensure that you indicate which nine you placed on your score sheet....

Play will be in foursomes. The Pro Shop will fill in players as required.

If you can't make your tee time, please call the Pro Shop and advise them as soon as possible....

PLAY

Nine holes of golf should take approximately 2 hours. To accommodate our growing numbers of golfers, we must keep to this pace

On par 5's, pick up your ball after a double par and score "10" This will help speed up your play.

Repair your ball marks on the green

Rakes must be placed back in the sand traps after use.

Remember, there are No Gimmies for our nine-hole club play.

Players are encouraged to observe the rules of golf and the standards of golf etiquette. To our experienced golfers we ask that you share your knowledge of the game with our beginners.

GUESTS

Guests are welcome if space permits and may play a maximum of three times, after that we ask that you join our league and share in the fun and prizes....

We are asking that they identify themselves as a guest on the entries forms used for the door prizes and on the 50/50 tickets.....

WEEKLY COMPETITIONS

Only members of the Kelowna Springs Business Ladies Nine Hole Golf League are eligible

for the weekly prizes. Gift certificates, with "Expiry Dates" are for Pro Shop merchandise, regular or discounted.

To be eligible for our game and skill prizes the score sheet must be handed in to the Pro Shop after you've completed the nine. This gives the Pro Shop time to start calculating our winners for the night.

If your playing 18 holes please make sure the score sheet is handed in between nines....

The committee will keep unclaimed prizes for two weeks, after that time the prize will be recycled...

WEEKLY DOOR PRIZES

Our door prizes are open to members and guests, however, you must be present to win. We welcome any contributions made by members or their business organizations....

YEAR END TOURNAMENT AND WIND UP

Our wind up tournament will be on Saturday, September 13th. It will be a 1:30 shot gun start.

The tournament will be a flight competition. The Pro shop will calculate a handicap based on your weekly "Nine Hole" scores.

This league is self-sufficient. The year-end prizes will be based in the initial membership fee of \$32.00, our 50/50 draw each week, our sponsors and any contributions made by members and business organizations.

Attendance prizes will be awarded based on the number of weeks you've attended. (You must have a minimum of "Five" weeks of attendance to qualify)

The committee will post your attendance the first Wednesday of September. If there is an error, you must notify us at the time because there will not be any changes made to our attendance record on the day of the tournament.
